ABOUT HACC'S THEATRE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE PROGRAM

For more than twenty years, Harrisburg Area Community College has offered outstanding children's theatre to the Harrisburg area. Since 1989, HACC has hosted schools in the Rose Lehrman Arts Center for an annual week-long outreach program that consisted of a professionally mounted production, a talk-back with the actors and director, and an opportunity to meet the cast one-on-one. This unique opportunity has evolved into an eagerly anticipated annual event which includes public performances. The entire week is guaranteed to sell-out quickly as our reputation for high quality, educational theatre is regionally recognized. In 1994, the Theatre for Young People was launched and began its first Summer Theatre Camps for Young People, which has since expanded to include the Saturday Studio Program held during the fall and spring. Annual enrollment exceeds 300 for theatrical training in HACC's state-of-the art facilities. The inception of the Touring Company, which offers performances, cost free, to area school districts with limited resources, occurred in 1995. In 1998, TYP began the annual tradition of hosting the Holiday Goodwill Party, which brings approximately 130 homeless and underprivileged children to the Wildwood Campus for a day filled with theatrical entertainment, food, gifts, and holiday magic.

TYP was created to provide an affordable venue for area young people to celebrate and gain exposure to every aspect of theatre including, but not limited to, acting, dance, makeup, puppetry, playwrighting, and designing sets, costumes and light. Under the umbrella of HACC's Theatre Program, TYP offers training to college theatre majors in performance, theatre management, and teacher mentoring. TYP firmly believes that programming should be accessible to all young people and, therefore promotes multi-cultural diversity, including opportunities for individuals who are mentally and physically challenged. Each year, TYP continues the tradition of providing excellence in children's theatre by maintaining exceptional standards while promoting theatre as a venue for honoring the integrity of each individual's creative potential.

DESCRIPTION: Designed for the beginning actor, this class will introduce basic acting techniques and training. Emphasis will be placed upon making strong acting choices with split-second timing. An excellent foundation class in which students are encouraged to register for several sessions as course content evolves based upon the skill level of participants.

JAZZ DANCE: Explore movement and learn the basics of jazz dance in this one hour a week class. Basic dance terminology will be introduced through warm-ups, across the floor exercises, and combinations done to musical theatre and jazz songs. All levels are welcome. No prior dance experience is necessary. Students may dance in bare feet, socks, or jazz shoes. Please wear appropriate clothing (no restrictive clothing).

TAP DANCE: Learn the basics of this fun style of dance while you increase your confidence and rhythm. Tap terminology will be taught using warm-ups, across the floor exercises, and combinations to musical theatre songs and other forms of music. A capella tap will also be taught. Tap is great for learning how music and beats work with each other. All levels are welcome. Please have a pair of tap shoes on the first day of class. Any style is acceptable. No restrictive clothing.

DESCRIPTION: Do you like to dance, move and play? If your answer is yes then this is the class for you. This class allows students to explore different dance styles ranging from Hip-hop, Jazz, Contemporary, Latin and Musical Theatre. The students will also have the opportunity to experiment through movement creating their own choreography individually and in group work. Each week will focus on one particular dance style, which will result in a performance the final day of class. No previous dance training is required.

DESCRIPTION: Curious as to why Shakespeare is considered by many to be the greatest playwright of all time? Do you every want to understand why his characters and plot lines are so widely popular and loved by actors and directors alike? What about all of those "thee" "thou" and "tis" words? What do they mean? This is the class for you! Students will look at Shakespearean language and how it works. "Try on" a few of the characters such as Romeo and Juliet, Hamlet, and Macbeth as you explore scenes from Shakespeare's most important plays. Examine costumes and props from the Elizabethan period. Finally, put your acting tools to use as you rehearse and perform some of the scenes written by "The Bard"!

**Please note! Content within each class changes every term, so students may repeat classes without fear of repetition. Classes are structured so individual ability levels are challenged.*
