ABOUT HACC'S THEATRE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE PROGRAM

For more than twenty years, Harrisburg Area Community College has offered outstanding children's theatre to the Harrisburg area. Since 1989, HACC has hosted schools in the Rose Lehrman Arts Center for an annual week-long outreach program that consisted of a professionally mounted production, a talk-back with the actors and director, and an opportunity to meet the cast one-on-one. This unique opportunity has evolved into an eagerly anticipated annual event which includes public performances. The entire week is guaranteed to sell-out quickly as our reputation for high quality, educational theatre is regionally recognized. In 1994, the Theatre for Young People was launched and began its first Summer Theatre Camps for Young People, which has since expanded to include the Saturday Studio Program held during the fall and spring. Annual enrollment exceeds 300 for theatrical training in HACC's state-of-the art facilities. The inception of the Touring Company, which offers performances, cost free, to area school districts with limited resources, occurred in 1995. In 1998, TYP began the annual tradition of hosting the Holiday Goodwill Party, which brings approximately 130 homeless and underprivileged children to the Wildwood Campus for a day filled with theatrical entertainment, food, gifts, and holiday magic.

TYP was created to provide an affordable venue for area young people to celebrate and gain exposure to every aspect of theatre including, but not limited to, acting, dance, makeup, puppetry, playwriting, and designing sets, costumes and light. Under the umbrella of HACC's Theatre Program, TYP offers training to college theatre majors in performance, theatre management, and teacher mentoring. TYP firmly believes that programming should be accessible to all young people and, therefore promotes multi-cultural diversity, including opportunities for individuals who are mentally and physically challenged. Each year, TYP continues the tradition of providing excellence in children's theatre by maintaining exceptional standards while promoting theatre as a venue for honoring the integrity of each individual's creative potential.

OUTREACH PROGRAM

HACC's Outreach Program will work with you to custom design a Theatre Program tailored to meet your organization's needs. We offer classes for all abilities and in all aspects of theatre for ages 5-18. Classes may be designed to include one-day workshops or extended programs.

Musical Theatre requires a combination of great singing, great acting, and the ability to move gracefully. In this class we will learn basic vocal production to maximize your sound, song presentation, and musical acting basics. In addition, each day you will focus upon dance and movement training as you rehearse a choreographed scene from different musical styles! A great way to increase your skills and improve your chance at getting the part you want in your school production! This class will be adapted to fit each student's ability level.

Strengthen your understanding of these basic forms to increase your confidence at Musical Theatre auditions!

CAMP #7 BROADWAY SHOWCASE

Vocal technique, dance, movement, and acting skills will be the focus of this musical theatre program in which you'll be with like-minded youth who are passionate about Broadway musicals. Spend your week working towards a final showcase in which you'll perform for family and friends!

CAMP #8 THEATRE EXPLORERS

A great introduction to the fun world of theatre for the young actor. Students will develop skills in concentration, self-awareness, physical expression and teamwork. Bring your imagination!

this camp may be combined with Camp #14 (Acting for the Camera) for a full day experience. **Students who enroll in both programs will enjoy a supervised lunch break (students must provide their own lunch).

DESCRIPTION: Improvisation requires students to think quickly on their feet while solving acting problems with greater clarity, wit, and skill. This is an excellent foundation class for actors of all abilities as you will use exercises to explore character development, improve verbal and non-verbal communication skills, and spark creativity — all in an atmosphere of great fun! Bring your energy and imagination!

CAMP #12 THE ACTING WORKSHOP

July 13th-July 17th Ages: 10-12
12:30 pm-2:30 pm Cost: \$75

this camp may be combined with Camp #10 (Total Body Improv/Theatre Sports) for a full day experience. **Students who enroll in both programs will enjoy a supervised lunch break (students must provide their own lunch).

CAMP #13 THE ACTING WORKSHOP

12:30 pm-2:30 pm Cost: \$75

this camp may be combined with Camp #11 (Total Body Improv/Theatre Sports) for a full day experience. **Students who enroll in both programs will enjoy a supervised lunch break (students must provide their own lunch).

DESCRIPTION: Designed for the beginning actor, this class will introduce basic acting techniques and training. Learn about characterization and interpretation, improving communication skills, thinking quickly on your feet, movement, and developing imagination while participating in improvised activities. Emphasis will be placed upon making strong acting choices with split-second timing. An excellent foundation class in which students are encouraged to register for several sessions as course content evolves based upon the skill level of participants.

CAMP #14 ACTING FOR THE CAMERA

August 3rd-7th Ages: 13-17
12:30 pm-2:30 pm Cost: \$85

this camp may be combined with Camp #11 (Total Body Improv/Theatre Sports) for a full day experience. **Students who enroll in both programs will enjoy a supervised lunch break (students must provide their own lunch).

DESCRIPTION: Explore the exciting world of TV and film acting! Students will learn the proper techniques for auditioning and performing on-camera. Focus will be on vocal quality, physical preparation, and commercial presentation. Each student will receive a video tape of their work! Class size is limited, so early registration is encouraged.
