## **ABOUT HACC'S THEATRE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE PROGRAM**

For more than twenty years, HACC has offered outstanding children's theatre to the Harrisburg area. Since 1989, HACC has hosted schools in the Rose Lehrman Arts Center for an annual week-long outreach program that consisted of a professionally mounted production, a talk-back with the actors and director, and an opportunity to meet the cast one-on-one. This unique opportunity has evolved into an eagerly anticipated annual event which includes public performances. The entire week is guaranteed to sell-out quickly as our reputation for high quality, educational theatre is regionally recognized. In 1994, the Theatre for Young People was launched and began its first Summer Theatre Camps for Young People, which has since expanded to include the Saturday Studio Program held during the fall and spring. Annual enrollment exceeds 300 for theatrical training in HACC's state-of-the-art facilities. The inception of the Touring Company, which offers performances, cost free, to area school districts with limited resources, occurred in 1995. In 1998, TYP began the annual tradition of hosting the Holiday Goodwill Party, which brings approximately 130 homeless and underprivileged children to the Harrisburg Campus for a day filled with theatrical entertainment, food, gifts, and holiday magic. TYP was created to provide an affordable venue for area young people to celebrate and gain exposure to every aspect of theatre including, but not limited to, acting, dance, makeup, puppetry, playwrighting, and designing sets, costumes and light. Under the umbrella of HACC's Theatre Program, TYP offers training to college theatre majors in performance, theatre management, and teacher mentoring. TYP firmly believes that programming should be accessible to all young people and, therefore, promotes multi-cultural diversity, including opportunities for individuals who are mentally and physically challenged. Each year, TYP continues the tradition of providing excellence in children's theatre by maintaining exceptional standards while promoting theatre as a venue for honoring the integrity of each individual's creative potential.

In addition, each day you will focus upon dance and movement training as you rehearse a choreographed scene from different musical styles! **DESCRIPTION:** Students who are interested in the dance aspects of Musical Theatre will greatly benefit from this class which spends one week introducing and exploring five of the most common dance styles found in theatre choreography. Each day will focus upon one of the following: Jazz, modern, tap, ballroom, and acrobatics. Strengthen your understanding of these basic forms to increase your confidence at Musical Theatre auditions!

**DESCRIPTION:** This camp is designed as a total theatre experience. Students will explore acting and improvisation, learn the practical skills of costume and scene design/construction, become more physically aware through movement and dance training, transform themselves with the magic of makeup, and have an outstanding time while making new friends! **IMPROVISATION THROUGH  
THEATRE SPORTS**

**DESCRIPTION:** Theatresports is improvised theatre entertainment/games played as a sport. Players are given suggestions from the audience for performing improvised scenes which are then awarded "points" by a "judge." Theatresports requires players to improvise and solve acting problems with greater clarity, wit, and skill. Participants will learn to think quickly on their feet and take greater risks with better overall communication. And... it is a great deal of fun!

**INTENSIVE ACTING WEEK**

**DESCRIPTION:** *Students who enroll in this camp are expected to have a good foundation of skills and experiences.* Emphasis will be on advanced acting exercises, auditioning techniques, monologue selection, and critiquing for better understanding and development.

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**CAMP #9****DREAM IT! DESIGN IT!  
AND BUILD A RENAISSANCE  
COSTUME!**

August 7th-11th

10:00 am – 3:00 pm

Ages 13-18

Cost: \$225

**DESCRIPTION:** In five days, students will design and construct a costume from the Renaissance period! On the first day of class, you will examine the historical styles of European clothing from the 12th-15th centuries. You will then design the costume, select the fabric from our enormous supply, and construct the costume using theatrical costume techniques. If you desire, you may construct the costume to fit you! During construction, you will be using our professional costume facilities and tools. At the end of the week, the costume is yours to keep. All supplies are included in the cost of the camp. The camp includes a short snack "mini-break," provided by the student.

**\*\*All students registering for this camp must have a working knowledge of a sewing machine and basic hand stitches. This camp is NOT for the beginning seamstress.**

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**CAMP #10****BUNRAKU, SHADOW, AND  
OTHER WORLD STYLES OF  
PUPPETRY FOR YOU!**

**DESCRIPTION:** Puppetry as an art form is enormously popular in non-American societies. Students in this hands-on class will explore Asian, African, and European styles of puppetry which go beyond the usual finger and hand styles commonly introduced in our schools. Each day, students will focus upon a different country and construct a puppet out of found materials to take home. Characterization and voice manipulation will be explored, which is highly useful for those students interested in acting. Tuition includes cost of materials, which are provided.

**DESCRIPTION:** Learning to move well is an important aspect of actor training. While not all actors are dancers, all actors should have sufficient movement training. If you enjoy watching dance videos, this is the class for you! Students will be introduced to the world of Hip-Hop, Jazz and Modern Movement as they learn how to beat count with isolation movement. By the end of the week, these techniques will be used to create three choreographed pieces from each of the three styles. Prior dance experience is NOT NECESSARY!
