HACC's Lancaster Campus offers one-stop enrollment event for fall classes

LANCASTER – Busy students planning to enroll for fall classes at HACC can come to a one-stop enrollment event from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. Wednesday, July 15, in the Main Building, room 216, on the Lancaster Campus of HACC, Central Pennsylvania's Community College, 1641 Old Philadelphia Pike.

During this special stop-in event, students can apply (with \$35 fee), complete placement testing, speak with an academic adviser, enroll in classes and find out about financial aid and payment options – all in one visit.

Completion time for the placement test is approximately two hours. Photo identification is required. Fall classes start Aug. 24.

"This one-stop event is the perfect opportunity for prospective students to complete all the steps necessary for enrollment and be ready for their fall classes."
