HACC's York Campus offers one-stop enrollment event for fall classes

York – Busy students planning to enroll for fall classes at HACC can come to a one-stop enrollment event from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. Wednesday, July 15, on the York Campus of HACC, Central Pennsylvania's Community College, 2010 Pennsylvania Ave.

During this special stop-in event, new students can apply to the college, complete placement testing, schedule an advising session and find out about financial aid and payment options – all in one visit.

Completion time for the placement test is approximately two hours. Photo identification is required. Day fall classes start Aug. 24. Evening and Saturday classes in York start the week of September 8th.

"If prospective students are considering starting classes at HACC, they need to know that classes are filling quickly," said Michele Bodani, the enrollment management coordinator at the York Campus. "We are seeing record enrollment in York again for this fall, most likely due to the economy. HACC is the most affordable option in the area."

New this fall at the York Campus is the heating, ventilation and air conditioning accelerated program – a hands-on, practical skills program for entry-level positions in a high-demand occupation that can be completed in just one semester. Students will learn to install, repair and maintain heating, air conditioning and refrigeration systems. Graduates work as service technicians, equipment installers or HVAC maintenance technicians. Graduates also can continue their studies for a certificate and/or an associate degree in HVAC.

Classes for the HVAC program will be held in the newest addition to the York Campus: the nearby 11-acre site that includes the William F. Goodling Center at 2101 Pennsylvania Ave. and Cytech complex where the next campus expansion is currently underway.
